Scope & Sequence



Course Overview: This course is a world cultures course organized around the topics of Geography, Demographics, Human Activity, Research & Communication Skills. Students learn basic map skills, conduct graph and table analysis, and learn basic geography and economics. Students leave this course with a core set of social studies analytical skills, the ability to write research essays, an understanding of the world map and knowledge of highlights of world history, government and geography. In contrast to the Traditional 6th Grade course, this course must be taught in 90-minute periods during a single semester.
